RESERVATION POLICY

- Campsites will be available for reservations after January 1st for the current year of 2nd weekend in April to 2nd weekend in October.
- 2). All reservations can be made in person, by mail, by e-mail, fax or by phone.
- 3). Reservations suggested but not required to stay. Reservations guarantee a space. Specific site will be assigned at time of arrival.
- 4). You can specify on river, off river or full hook-up only. Park office will indicate site number upon arrival.
- Reservation requests are suggested to be received at least two weeks prior to the beginning of stay. Payment in full is required at time of reservation.
- 6). All cancellations must be made 14 days in advance of arrival date for a full refund minus a \$20 service fee. Full payment will be forfeited for any cancellation within 14 days of your scheduled arrival date.
- 7). Unless the park is notified, a campsite not occupied within 24 hours of the reservation start date will be considered available for other campers.
- 8). No refunds will be given for any reason after site is occupied.
- 9). No personal checks for under one week of rent.
- 10). All reservations for holiday weekends (Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day) will require a 3-night minimum stay.

RULES

- 1). Speed limit is 10 mph.
- 2). All sites must be renewed by 11:00 AM on the scheduled departure date or they will be considered available for other campers. Check out time is 12:00 Noon. Check in time 1 PM.
- 3). Before changing sites, check with park office first.
- 4). Only one camping unit per site. One additional tent allowed at \$10/night. Additional tent must be on site. No more than two vehicles per site. All others must park in designated area.
- 5). Dogs and other pets must be kept on a 6' leash at all times. Dogs cannot be left alone at site. Dogs and other pets shall be walked in designated walk area. All droppings by your pet shall be cleaned up immediately and deposited in dumpster.
- 6). Fires are allowed only in firepits, grills or approval areas. Please do not cut any trees or shrubs in the park.
- 7). Quiet time is 11:00 p.m.
- 8). All fish must be cleaned at fish cleaning station.
- 9). The management will not be responsible for losses, damages or injuries to your party.
- 10). Absolutely no dumping of gray water or sewage on ground. All containers must have tight fitting lids and dumped only at dumping station. No dumping of live wells. THIS IS A STATE LAW!
- 11). Please put trash in plastic bags and place in dumpster located near entrance of the park.
- 12). No more than two vehicles per site. All others must park in designated area. All vehicles must be parked off the roadway.
- 13). River frontage on sites 7-32 must be shared with other off-river campers; access from sidewalk. A kayak/small boat launch is available for use.

AU GRES RIVERFRONT CAMPGROUND/PARK

The Au Gres Riverfront Campground is one of the area's most popular destination campgrounds. The campground features 108 campsites and 2 rental cabins available for daily, weekly, monthly or seasonal rental. All of the campsites have water and electric hook ups, a fire pit and a picnic table. 25 of the sites also include sewer hook-up and 33 sites (no sewer) are located on the banks of the Au Gres River. The campground also includes a centrally located playground area for children, a kayak/small boat ramp to explore the river and a fish cleaning station for successful anglers.

Located adjacent to the Au Gres Riverfront Campground is the City Park. This day use park features playground equipment, tennis, pickle ball, basketball and volleyball courts. Baseball fields and horseshoe pits are also located at the park. Two pavilions, one 60x100 enclosed and one 24x32 open air are also available for rent.

There is plenty to do within a short distance of the campground; Riverside Park attractions include a splash pad, a nautical themed play area, an ADA kayak launch and a fishing pier. Riverside Park also has boater mooring facilities available for rent by the day, week, month or season with discounted rates for registered campers. The Old Airport Disc Golf course is only minutes away. This top rated 19-hole course is nestled in a wooded setting. Even if you are not a golfer, you are welcome to hike this pristine property. Grocery stores and a few of Au Gres' unique shops are a short walk across the pedestrian bridge from the campground.

Au Gres is the center of Northeast Michigan accessibly for boating and recreational fishing. The MiDNR public boat ramp is located a mile from the Riverfront Campground. From there, you are only minutes to Saginaw Bay and Lake Huron for some of the best perch and walleye fishing the State of Michigan has to offer. The Riverside Park fish cleaning station is located near the ramp is free to use (donations welcome) after your successful fishing excursion.
